# LA CUISINE **CASTLE OF NÈGREPELISSE REHABILITATED BY RCR ARQUITECTES**

# **OPENED JUNE 14TH 2014**

Built in the 13th century, the castle of Nègrepelisse was commissioned by the Viscounts of Bruniquel. Throughout the centuries, it has undergone many transformations, from destruction to metamorphosis. In 2014, the ruins of the castle were rehabilitated by the prestigious Catalan architects of RCR Arquitects (Pritzker Price 2017).

Respecting the medieval design, RCR proposed a restoration of the ramparts from which the new building emerges. The contrast between the external barricade, which takes the shape of a fortified castle, and the modern interior with its large windows, allows the landscape to filter in exquisitely. The ancient fortress gives way to a modern building full of life.

Part of the new architecture plan, the inner courtyard has been imagined as an extension of the public space to welcome the public for temporary exhibitions, events and concerts especially during the period of summer.

Imagined like a creative tool, Les Fourneaux is an experimental kitchen connected to the art centre, it is a privileged place to exchange ideas and engage a dialogue with the public.

La cuisine is a lively and friendly place with events all year round including workshops, talks, performances, readings and concerts.
